

Deer Creek Camp is **excited** to open our gates May 31!

We are eager to see all the new and familiar faces of summer. The governor of Texas has approved overnight summer camps to open
amid COVID-19.

Here is what precautions Deer Creek Camp is putting into place to
ensure that both campers and staff are healthy during camp.

Deer Creek Camp Cleaning/Disinfecting/Sanitizing Procedures

The safety and well-being of our counselors and campers continues to be a top priority here at Deer Creek Camp. We will continue to monitor and adjust our health and safety procedures that are already in place.

Bunkhouses

Mattresses, broom handles, trash cans, doorknobs, switches, A/C units sprayed with a disinfectant and wiped down. Floors mopped with a disinfecting cleaner. Completed on changeover weekends.

Bathhouses

Toilets, sinks, counters, trash cans cleaned with bleach based cleaner.

Floors mopped with disinfecting solution. Daily and Changeover weekends

Great Hall

Hallways, common areas, mopped with disinfecting solution. Door knobs, handles and surfaces disinfected. Daily and changeover weekends

Kitchen Dining Area

Picnic tables, benches, food surfaces, drink station sanitized after each meal as part of KP cabin duty.

Eating utensils, buffet line, coffee bar, carts, sinks, kitchen counters, floors, sanitized between each meal.

Hand Sanitizers will be stationed around camp and at buffet line entrance.

Arrival

Opening Day check in will be staggered. This will alleviate crowding in Great Hall as medicine is handed in, store money processed, and bunks are made up in cabins. You will be assigned a time slot for check in.

Mealtime

Cabins will be dismissed to go through food line as usual. Salad Bar will be served from the line by staff. Juices and milks will be handed out in cartons, dressings and syrups and condiments will be served in packets. "Sneeze guards" have already been installed on serving line.

Closing Ceremony

We are still working on this process and will let you know changes when it all comes together.

Health Affidavit

The safety and well-being of our counselors and campers continues to be a top priority here at Deer Creek Camp. We will continue to monitor and adjust our health and safety procedures that are already in place.

Thankfully, due to the nature of this virus, the youth at our camp are in the “little to no risk” category. It is also comforting to know that there are no reported cases of COVID-19 in the Medina area. Still, we are preparing to operate with vigilance and precaution.

Our camps are continuing as planned and we are praying that illness or virus will not hinder what God plans to accomplish in the hearts and minds of counselors, medical staff, and campers.

Included in this summer’s procedures:

Pre-camp screening of campers and counselors for sickness through signed affidavit

Temperatures taken/recorded at check in

Covering of mouth and nose when sneezing with tissue or coughing into elbow

Washing hands frequently- hand sanitizers available in strategic areas

Frequent disinfecting of objects and surfaces

Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth, and face

The following form will need to be handed in at check in. Temperatures will be taken with a heat sensitive hand-held touch to forehead prior to leaving car.

We acknowledge and affirm that:

The camper, nor anybody in the immediate camper family has been knowingly

- a. exposed to COVID-19 or any other form of influenza during the fourteen days prior to camp arrival or,
- b. been sick with COVID-19 or other form of influenza or run a temperature during the fourteen days prior to camp arrival.
